- *Ensure transparency in operations and transactions in relation to data transfer from the platform.*

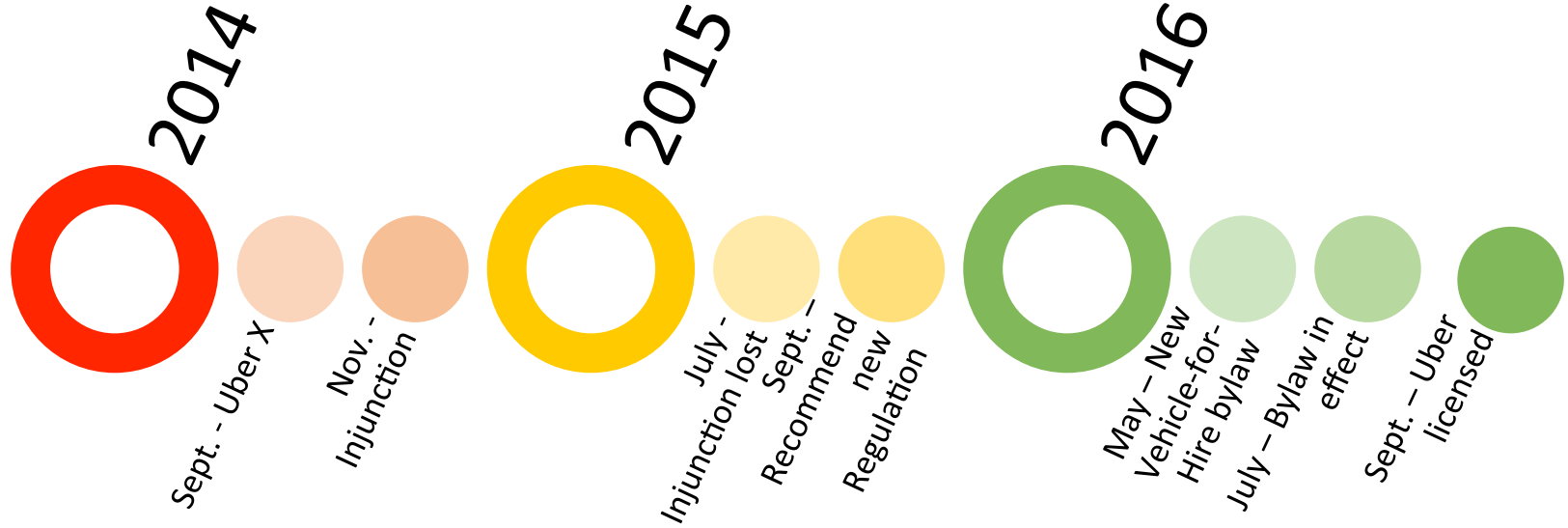

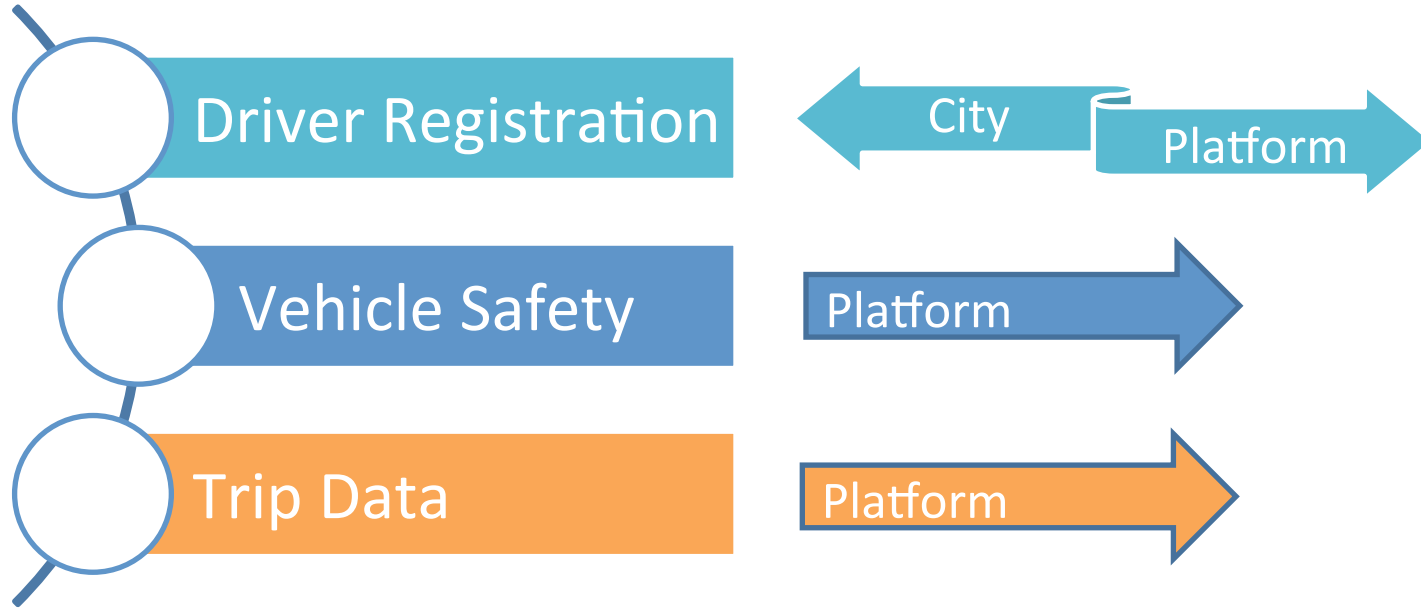

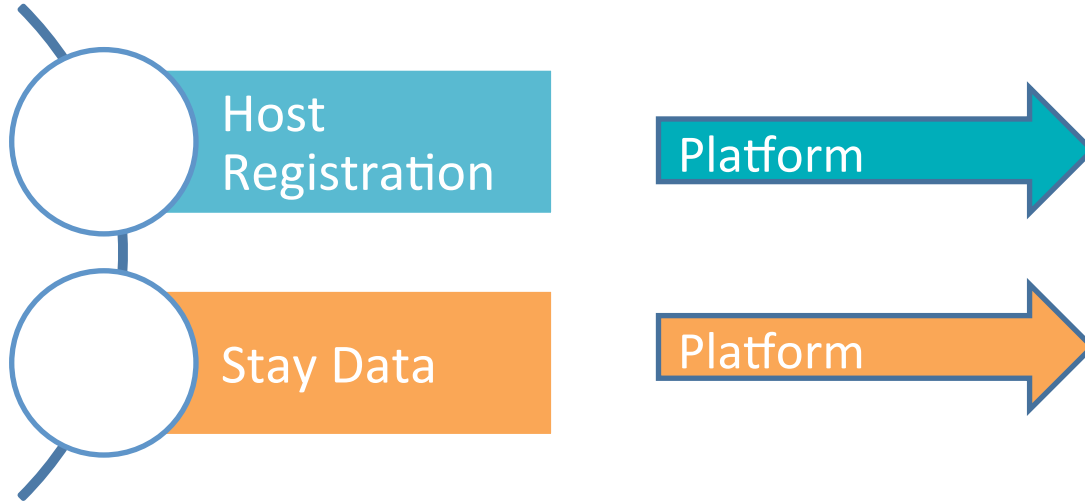
Path of Disruption - Uber



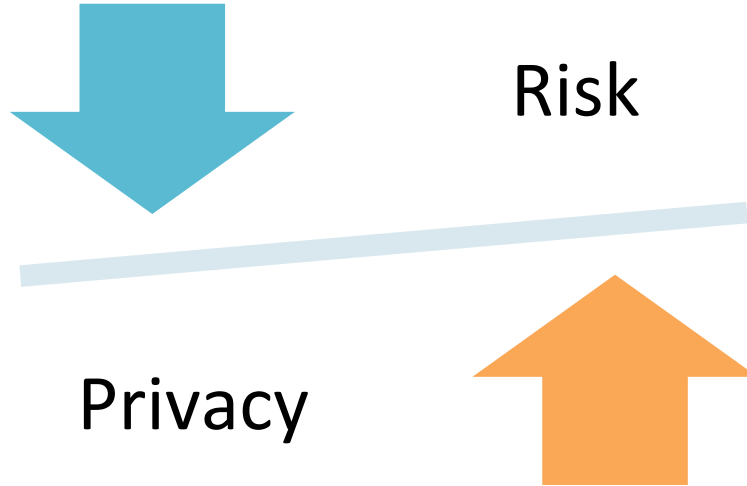

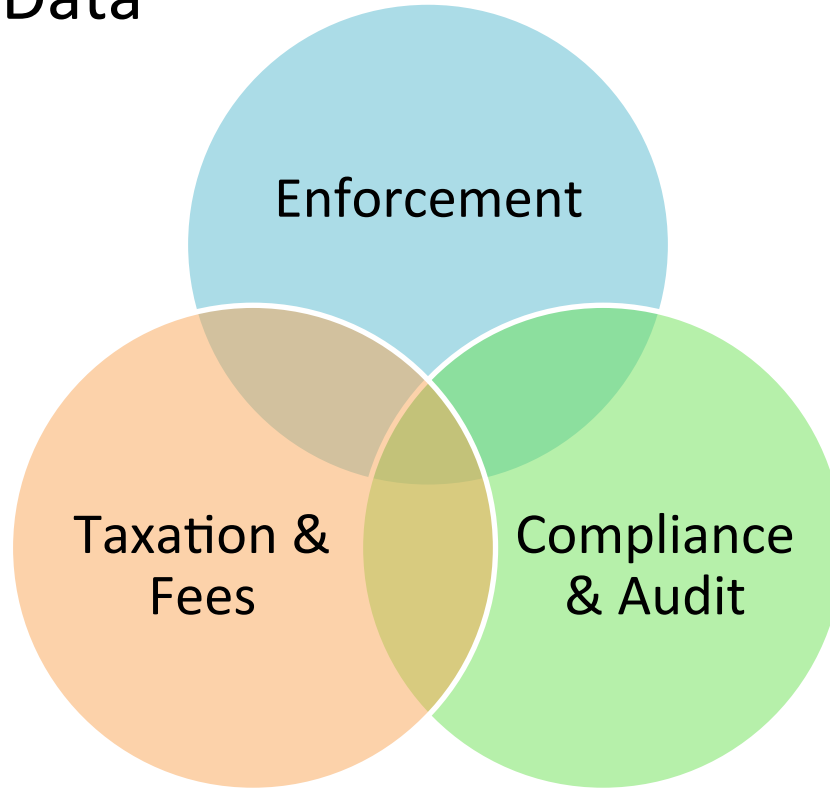

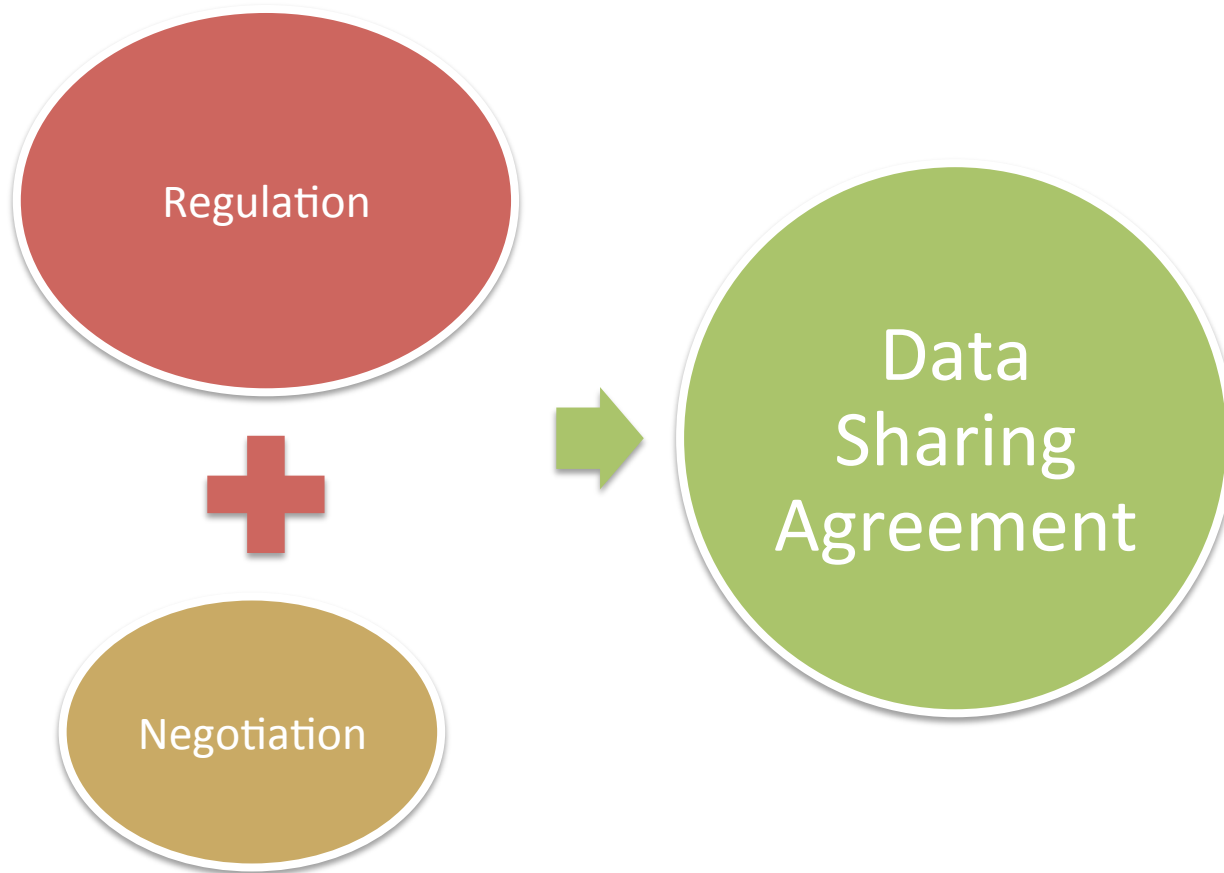
