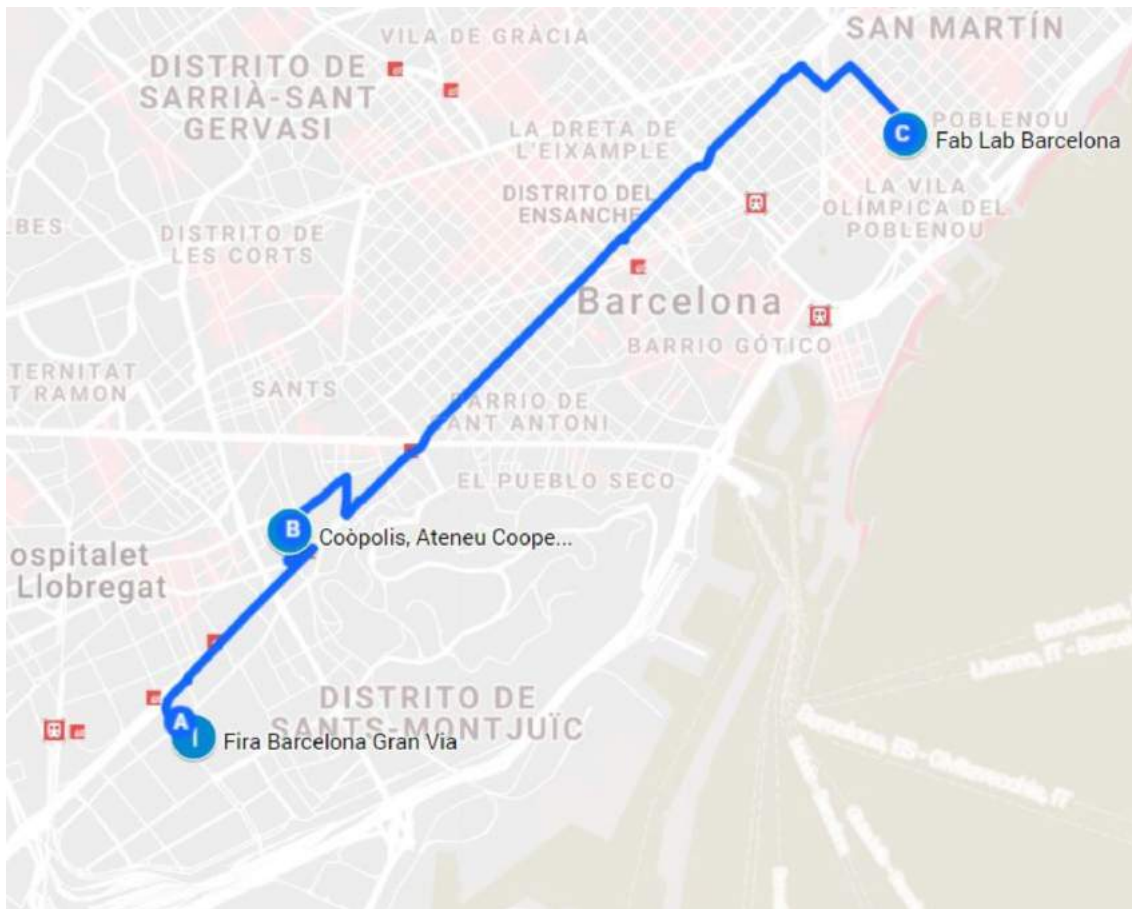

STOP 1

Can Batlló (La Bordeta)

Can Batlló, also known as the old Joan Batlló Factory, is a former industrial complex located close to the Gran Via de les Corts Catalanes. After a lot of pressure from neighbours, "Block 11" became independent in 2011 and is now self-managed by cession from Barcelona municipality. There are currently a number of interesting projects and experiments being run there to develop the area further. You will meet four such projects during our tour:

Shared and electric mobility, Cooperatives

Som Mobilitat is a non-profit consumer cooperative that offers mobility products and services to accelerate the transition towards a more sustainable shared electric mobility. Their mobility model is committed to promoting walking, cycling and public transport, and, if none of these options are available on a certain route, the use of shared electric vehicles.

The cooperative startup was launched in Mataró (35 km north of Barcelona) and is active in 5+ cities within the Barcelona Metropolitan area. Its' service is expanding rapidly with 20+ cities in the pipeline.

Democratic innovation and participation

Decidim is a participatory democracy initiative launched by the city council of Barcelona. Its' success has been a big step towards building a more democratic city and empowering citizens. Decidim is an open source software project, which means it can be easily used for participatory democracy initiatives in other cities and organizations. A number of cities are already using the platform, such as Helsinki (FI), Veracruz (MX), Lille (FR) and Pamplona (ES).



STOP 2

Fab Lab Barcelona @ Makers District Poblenu

On of the largest digital fabrication laboratories in the world and the leader of the Fab City network.

Fab Lab Barcelona was among the first digital manufacturing laboratories in the European Union. The founders and directors of this project are also the instigators of the global FabCity movement. The Fabcity concept is being prototyped in the neighborhood of Poblenu, the city's "Maker District", where the Fablab is located.

In addition to learning about the Maker District we will also hear about Digital Social Innovation projects born in the Fablab Barcelona, such as Smart Citizen (open source sensors and data), Making Sense (citizen participation) and Aquapionners (food, crowdfunding), among others.

THE FAB CITY PROTOTYPE

Poblenu Neighbourhood, Barcelona

A Fab City is a new urban model for locally productive and globally connected self-sufficient cities that shifts how cities source and use materials by bringing back production to distributed and smaller scales. More production occurs inside the city, neighbourhoods and citizens' homes, along with recycling materials and meeting local needs through local inventiveness. In Barcelona's Poblenu district, this model is being constructed through an evergrowing web of leaders, makerspaces and citizens.

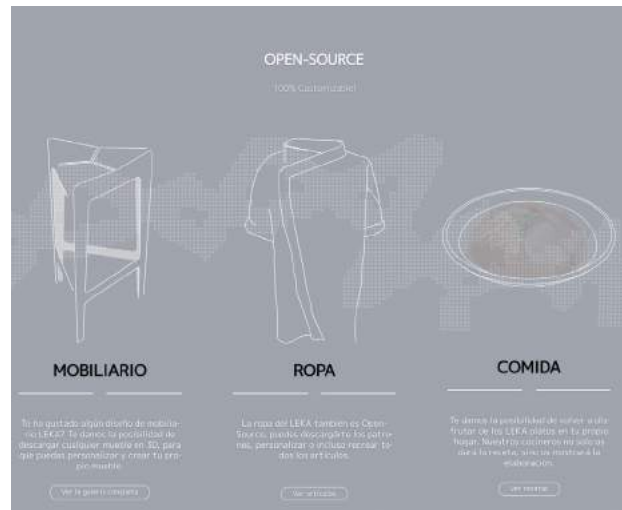
